MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUXILIARY

Women and men who join the Auxiliary (established in 1957) of Memorial Hospital make lasting friendships while providing essential assistance, support and financial aid for many of the hospital needs. The auxiliary is a self-directed body of volunteers responding to the needs of the hospital community through service.

Active Membership

You may be as active as your time and commitments permit. As an auxiliary volunteer, you will receive recognition for hours of service and free meals while volunteering within the hospital. Most importantly, you will have the satisfaction of knowing you are making a contribution to the quality of healthcare provided in the community.

The hospital gift shop is a major source of raising funds to accomplish various projects around the hospital facility. It is a non-profit establishment wherein members can volunteer at least 1 day a month.

Inactive Membership

If you are interested in meeting and helping people you can contribute both physically and/or financially. All auxiliary members are invited to attend the Annual General Meeting each spring as well as the Annual Christmas Meeting which features a delicious meal and guest speaker.
